

INSTALLATION

1. Park the vehicle on a hard, level surface and engage the emergency brake. Place chocks in front and behind the wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses
2. Raise the vehicle until the axle hangs free. Rest the frame on safety jack stands rated for the weight of the vehicle. Removal of the wheel is optional.
3. Starting on the driver side, wipe the coil spring using a damp cloth to remove all debris from the center three coils. Apply soapy water to the coil to make installation easier.
4. The Coil SumoSpring has one deeper coil groove and one shallower. Make sure that the deeper groove is installed on the bottom.
5. Start the Coil SumoSpring installation between the second and third turns from the top of the coil. Place it around the coil spring like a collar with the ends toward the outside.
6. Using your hands, slide the bottom of the Coil SumoSpring (deeper groove) onto the coil until it is fully seated. Continue this motion until it is fully seated about a quarter way around the coil spring. Then, using your fingers, push the upper groove until it sits under the coil directly above it. With the palm of your other hand begin to push it into position between the turns of the coil spring.

NOTE: Installation shouldn't require any tools. However, if the fit is tight, you may use a dull tool (e.g. flat head screwdriver) to help pop the Coil SumoSpring into place.

7. Continue this motion until the Coil SumoSpring is fully inserted into the coil spring. Preferably, it should sit on the center turn of the coil.

NOTE: After you have installed your Coil SumoSprings, if the ends are overlapping more than 1 inch, you may need to cut off the excess overlap. Cut the excess of the Coil SumoSprings so that you have an overlap of 1/2" to 1".

8. Repeat steps 3 through 7 on the passenger side of the vehicle.
9. Raise the vehicle, remove safety jack stands, and carefully lower vehicle to the hard surface. Remove the chocks in front and back of the rear wheels.
10. Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found in the box your part came in.



INSTALLATION

1. Park the vehicle on a hard, level surface and engage the emergency brake. Place chocks in front and behind wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.
2. Raise the rear of the vehicle allowing the axle to hang free and rest the frame on the safety jack stands rated for the weight of the vehicle. Removal of the rear wheels is optional.
3. Starting on the driver side, remove the factory bump stops from the underside of the frame.
4. Take two of the 3/8" Tag Nuts [ITEM E] and bend the tangs up at about a 45 degree angle. Place them through the oval hole on the inside of the frame rail.
5. Attach the Drivers Side Upper Mounting Bracket A [ITEM B] to the bottom of the frame rail using the factory bump stop and bolt, but leave it loose for now.
6. Place two of the 3/8" Fender Washers [ITEM J] behind the rear hole of the upper mounting bracket.
7. Insert one 3/8 x 1 1/2" Flange Bolt [ITEM H] through the rear hole of the bracket, the 3/8" Fender Washers [ITEM J], and the large hole in the frame. Thread the bolt into the 3/8" Tag Nuts [ITEM E] and fasten until finger-tight.
8. Insert one 3/8 x 1 1/2" Flange Bolt [ITEM H] through the front hole of the bracket and through the hole in the frame. Thread the bolt into the 3/8" Tag Nuts [ITEM E] and fasten until finger-tight.
9. Torque the two mounting bolts and the bump stop bolt to 25 ft. lbs.
10. Fasten the Upper Mounting Bracket B [ITEM C] to the top half of the SumoSpring [ITEM A] using two 3/8 x 3/4" Flange Bolts [ITEM I] through the forward two slots in the bracket and fasten until finger-tight.

11. Attach the Upper Mounting Bracket B [ITEM C] to the Upper Mounting Bracket A [ITEM B] using four 3/8 x 1 1/2" Flange Bolts [ITEM H] and 3/8" Locking Flange Nuts [ITEM G]. Use a torque wrench to tighten the bolts to 25 ft. lbs.

NOTE: 2WD trucks use the upper set of holes and 4WD trucks use the lower set of holes.

12. Attach the Lower Mounting Bracket [ITEM D] to the bottom half of the SumoSpring [ITEM A] with one 3/8 x 3/4" Flange Bolts [ITEM I] and fasten until finger-tight.
13. Place the Lower Mounting Bracket [ITEM D] on top of the factory leaf spring so that it straddles the factory top plate. Attach the bracket to the leaf pack using two 3/8" U-Bolts [ITEM F] and four 3/8" Locking flange nuts [ITEM G] and fasten them loosely.
14. Repeat steps 3 through 13 on the passenger side.
15. Once the installation on both sides is at this point, use a jack to raise the axle so the upper and lower halves of the SumoSPrings are almost touching.
16. Using the adjustment slots, align the two halves of the SumoSPrings so they sit vertically aligned.
17. With the driver and passenger sides aligned, tighten the u-bolt nuts securely without tightening to the point of bending the bracket. Torque the rest of the hardware to 25 ft. lbs.
18. Raise the vehicle and remove the safety jack stands.
19. Carefully lower vehicle to the hard surface and remove the chocks from the wheels.
20. Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found in the box your part came in.
