

INSTALLATION

1. Park the vehicle on a hard, level surface and engage the emergency brake. Place chocks in front and behind wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.

2. Raise the rear of the vehicle allowing the axle to hang free and rest the frame on the safety jack stands rated for the weight of the vehicle. Removal of the rear wheels is optional.

3. Starting on the driver side, un-bolt and remove the two nuts holding the existing factory bump stop mounting plate to the underside of the frame.

4. Remove the existing factory bump stop from the factory mounting plate.

5. Assemble the Sumospring [ITEM A], $3" \times \frac{1}{2}"$ Spacers [ITEM C], and $4" \times 1"$ Spacer [ITEM D] as indicated in the diagram. The diagram shows the configuration for the least air gap and most engagement. If more air gap (less engagement) is desired, spacers can be removed.

ATTENTION: At least one of the 3" x ¹/₂" Spacers [ITEM C] must be used for proper fit to factory mounting plate.

6. Reinstall the factory mounting plate with Sumospring assembly to the frame in the original location using the factory nuts.

7. Repeat steps 3 through 6 on the passenger side of the vehicle.

8. If rear wheels were removed you can now reinstall the rear wheels and torque wheel nuts to manufacturers specifications.

9. Jack up vehicle, remove safety jack stands.

10. Remove wheel chocks from the front wheels.

11. Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found in the box your part came in.
