

# **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **INSTALLATION**

- **1.** Park vehicle of level hard surface. Place wheel chocks in front and behind the front wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.
- **2.** Raise the rear of the vehicle allowing the axle to hang free and rest the frame on the safety jack stands rated for the weight of the vehicle. Removal of the rear wheels is optional.
- **3.** Starting on the driver side, un-bolt and remove the factory bump stop from the underside of the frame and set aside.
- **4.** Attach the Mounting Bracket [ITEM B] to the frame by inserting the stud into the same hole from which the factory bump stop was removed. Position the bracket so that the open side is facing inboard as in the diagram.
- **5.** Secure the bracket in place using the 3/8-16 Nylock Nut [ITEM E] and 3/8 Flat Washer [ITEM D] and tighten firmly.

# **CAUTION:** Do NOT over tighten nut or bracket will bend.

- **6.** Attach SumoSpring [ITEM A] to the rear hole of the mounting bracket using 3/8-16 x ¾" Flange Bolt [ITEM C] and torque to 25 ft. lbs. (see diagram)
- **7.** Repeat steps 3 through 6 on the passenger side of the vehicle.

**NOTE:** If more engagement is desired, the SumoSpring may be mounted to the bracket using the 1" Spacer [ITEM F] and  $3/8-16 \times 13$ " Flange Bolt [ITEM G].

- **8.** If rear wheels were removed you can now reinstall the rear wheels and torque wheel nuts to manufacturers specifications.
- 9. Jack up vehicle, remove safety jack stands.
- **10.** Remove wheel chocks from the front wheels.
- **11.** Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found in the box your part came in.
